2019 REGISTRATIONS In Order: 1) Register Club 2) Register SAEF 3) Register VASA	All vaulters, lungers, foreign athletes, foreign lungers, horses and officials must be registered with a registered and recognised club, the Vaulting Association of South Africa (VASA) before the close of entry date (NO EXCEPTIONS) . Please consult the VASA website for Registration details and costs. This information must be sent to the VASA administrator Shelley Paveley on admin@vaultingsa.co.za and be available for auditing BEFORE the close of entry date.
HORSE USAGE	VASA APPENDICES (8 Aug 2018) - Horse usage as per APPENDIX I 1. In 1 competition day, no horse shall be used for more than 12 canter rounds of 1 minute each or the equivalent (for example 6 canter rounds of 2 minutes each) and 24 walk rounds of 2 minutes each or the equivalent (for example, 48 walk rounds of 1 minute each). The OC reserves the right to change the rounds according to times and horse usage i.e. one & one and half to two rounds per class and rule 71.12.3 applies.
MEDICS	Will be stationed on the property of the Indoor arena

TIMES	Starting time: Saturday, 8h00 (Horse inspection for Inter Africa Horses) Times on the programme are provisional and only a guideline. If classes are running early they will follow on.

Music is the responsibility of the athlete and coach.
HORSE VACCINATIONS AND PASSPORTS	Gauteng Vaulting will be checking all Horse Passports 2 x per annum. The onus is upon each vaulter/coach/owner to make sure vaccinations are up to date. A fine and Yellow Card will be issued to the owner of any horse contravening these rules. WE WILL BE CHECKING PASSPORTS AT THIS SHOW
GENERAL	Catering will be available. No dogs allowed on the property. Competitors may NOT use the competition indoor arena one week before the competition date outside of the competition times. Horse owners/vaulters/grooms/coaches are responsible for picking up horse droppings and personal litter in yard, paddocks, practice and competition arena.
PRIZES	Rosettes for horse classes and certificates for barrel.
PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY	For Inter Africa Competition Will be held on Sunday, 19 May 2019. All team members are expected to be at the prize giving. For GVC 4 and SANESA Q3 Will be held approx ½ hour after the last class on the final day of the show. In respect of prize-giving, Gauteng Vaulting reserves the right to combine male/female or age categories should there be insufficient entries per category. Each competitor is required to attend prize giving unless a personal request is made to the Show Director in the case of a legitimate excuse. VASA rule 71.17.0 Prize giving ceremony applies.
RULES	NEW RULES 6 August 2018 WILL APPLY. Please all familiarise yourselves with these new rules which came into effect on 6 August 2018, available on the VASA website www.vaultingsa.co.za under Downloads. The organisers reserve the right to consolidate the duration of the show into one day as well as amend the number of Rounds depending on the number of entries, cancel, combine and restrict classes and/or age and gender groups. No parent, coach or vaulter or any other persons may approach the judges directly during the show for any reason whatsoever, all queries, complaints etc must be presented to and discussed with THE SHOW DIRECTOR ONLY. Any complaints of any nature must follow the SAEF General Regulations. A form must be obtained from the Show Director, filled in and R1000 money deposited up to 30 minutes after the last class. The show organisers and/or the show holding body will not entertain any complaints unless this procedure has been followed. The Show organizers or their representatives and officials will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, theft or injury sustained by horses, vaulters, appointed officials, the public or their property whatsoever. Rule 71.1.2 The horse may be changed up to 30 MINUTES before the start of the 1st test of the competition of that particular horse. Any substitutions must be presented on the official substitution form to the Show director ONLY and confirmed within the time period stipulated above. All substituted horses MUST be entered in the event and registered with VASA and SAEF and failure to adhere to this requirement will entail disqualification. Rule 71.1.3 In a squad, a vaulter may be substituted with the reserve vaulter within 30 minutes before the start of the 1st test of the competition for squads. This substitution must be presented on the official form to the show director ONLY and confirmed within the time period stipulated above. All substituted vaulters MUST be entered in the event and registered with VASA and SAEF and failure to adhere to this requirement will entail disqualification. There may only be 1 substitution per event. If a member of the squad is injured or ill (Doctors Note required), during a test they may be substituted with the reserve for the next test/tests with the accompanied substitution form as listed above.

	VASA rule 71.16.0 Prize Giving Ceremony - In order to participate at awards presentations, vaulters must be dressed in provincial tracksuits/attire or unitards. Lungers must be neat and smartly dressed. Suitable closed toe shoes are obligatory.
